An Erasmus Intensive Programme (IP) is a short programme of study which brings together students and instructors from higher education institutions of different countries to teach a combination of specialist topics. The IP on "Multimedia and the Future Internet: Moving Social and Mobile" focuses on some of the most challenging themes within the ICT arena: students and teachers will work together in international classroom environment to gain new perspectives on the Future Internet from different perspective: multimedia encoding and delivery, peer-to-peer networks, video streaming, quality of experience, online social networks, data mining and recommendation systems.

For approximately two weeks, students and instructors will participate to: lectures; interactive work; round-table and plenary discussions; quality evaluation of all activities.

Admitted participants will receive free full board accommodation for the entire duration of the IP, reimbursement of 90% of the documented travel expenses (airfare, train, public transportation), and free day trip to Bletchley Park, the historic site of secret British codebreaking activities during WWII and birthplace of the modern computer.

The Intensive Programme (IP) is mainly targeted at students that are currently pursuing a doctoral degree in ICT in one of the partner universities. MSc and BSc students will also be considered.
